

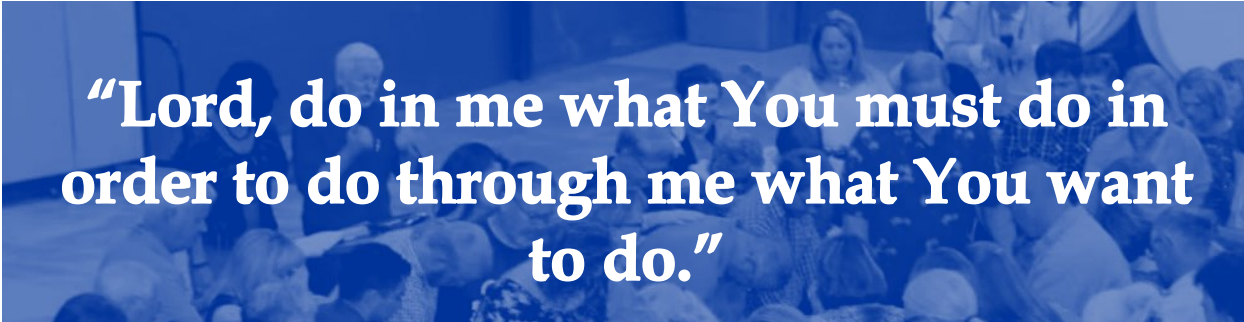

Women's Bible Study meets **every** Monday. On the 2nd Monday of each month, the ladies roll bandages for missions. [Click here](#) for more information.

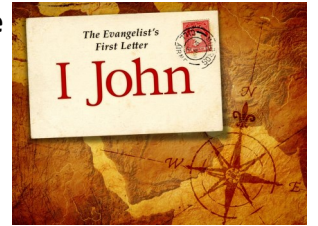
