

Women's Bible Study meets **every** Monday. On the 2nd Monday of each month, the ladies roll bandages for missions. <u>Click here</u> for more information.


All are welcome to meet at Smokey Bear Restaurant in Capitan for Breakfast at 8:30 a.m. on Mondays.
